I won't give out tests for any subject until all students have taken a particular exam. Please be sure to take any tests that you were scheduled to take while absent as soon as you return•It is up to you to come to me to schedule a time to take the test

Once you've received 8 perfect behavior certificates, staple them together and turn them in for a free homework pass. After turning in 8, you will only need to turn in 5 for your next free homework pass...3 after 8 then 5:)

Only if it is very important should you be able to come to the classroom in the morning. If you need to come, please tell me in advance or have mom or dad write a note asking if you can come to the room

early.

If I can't read your handwriting, please type your assignments. Remember, you may earn extra credit by typing your work. Anyone can earn extra credit for typing their work. Typing is a skill you will need to have in high school and beyond. Take advantage of the opportunity to practice this skill and earn extra credit.

Please check your behavior card. You will need to make arrangements to stay to complete work for any marks on your card.

Please be specific when telling your parents the reason for staying after school. It is your responsibility to inform your parents as to why you received a mark on your behavior card.

When calling home...

1. students must sign in the book and write down the reason why they are making a call. If they do not sign in they have no proof they were here making a call.
2. students must leave a message whenever possible. Parents call back and Mrs. Dobles doesn't know what to tell them.
3. If calling because of illness/need to go home- wait and speak to Mrs. Dobles before getting things to go home so she can mark the Health/Illness form and get the info on the attendance sheet. Students shouldn't come to the office with their things until it is verified that they are leaving.

All tests/quizzes are to be done the same class period or completed after school the same day or the following morning between 7:30 a.m.-8:00 a.m. no exceptions!

Grades are posted online once a week. The grades reflect the prior week scores. I do not have the ability to post new grades until the following Monday. Any missing work this week will may not appear until 10-19-10 after 5pm.

SATURDAY SCHOOL

Any behavior deemed serious enough by the principal could earn a student a spot in Saturday

School. The principal will supervise Saturday School, which will run for two hours on Saturday morning with the time being set by the principal. A few but not all of the things that will lead to immediate Saturday School are 1) throwing ANYTHING in the auditorium during lunchtime, 2) note writing, note passing and note reading, 3) fighting, 4) cheating, 5) talking during fire drills or tornado drills, 6) multiple behavior detentions, 7) having five or more incomplete homework assignments in one week (pg 26 in the school handbook).

No one is allowed in the classroom before school begins without a note from me or their parent. Students may not come to the classroom because homework has not been finished on the day it is due. Be sure to check with a partner each evening before you pack your backpack to have all the books you need to complete the assigned homework.

Students in charge of homework: please be sure to gather all papers including papers in the mailbox, worksheets and handouts for any student absent. There are folders for students who is absent. Please place all paperwork in folder.

Students who are absent: please be sure to bring back folder and turn in all homework from the time you are absent. Work will be counted late and you will have to stay after school if you turn in late work. You are responsible for checking the website for lesson plans when you are absent. If you have questions while absent you are welcome to e-mail me.

FYI- There are folders for people who are absent in the back of the classroom. You will recognize the folder by its cover...it is one of the KVSS radio station folders. If you are absent and receive your homework in the folder, make sure you return the folder when you arrive back to school.

1) ANY STUDENT WHO STAYS FOR HOMEWORK DETENTION, STUDY HALL OR TUTORING IS TO COME TO THE FRONT LOBBY TO WAIT FOR HIS/HER RIDE, CALL AND WAIT, OR GO TO EXTENDED CARE. ONLY IF A STUDENT IS WALKING HOME MAY HE/SHE LEAVE OUT OF ANOTHER DOOR. NO STUDENT WILL BE KEPT AFTER FOR LONGER THAN 4:10 (ONE HOUR) UNLESS YOU HAVE NOTIFIED A PARENT AND RECEIVED CONFIRMATION OF KEEPING THE STUDENT LONGER.

2) ANY STUDENT STAYING FOR HOMEWORK DETENTION MUST STAY A CERTAIN AMOUNT OF TIME FOR EACH HOMEWORK MARK. THEY MAY NOT LEAVE WHEN THEIR WORK IS DONE UNLESS THEIR INITIAL HW DETENTION TIME IS SERVED. I BELIEVE THE TIME IS DIFFERENT FOR EACH GRADE. PLEASE LET ME KNOW HOW LONG A HW DETENTION IS-MINIMALLY.

3) NO STUDENTS ARE TO BE OUTSIDE AFTER 3:20 PM WAITING FOR A RIDE ANYWHERE ON THE CAMPUS. THEY MUST COME IN AND EITHER GO TO EXTENDED CARE OR CALL AND CHECK ON THE STATUS OF HIS/HER RIDE AND WAIT IN THE SCHOOL LOBBY.

4) THERE SHOULD NOT BE ANY STUDENTS STAYING ON FRIDAY, UNLESS YOU HAVE NOTIFIED A PARENT AND RECEIVED CONFIRMATION OF KEEPING THE STUDENT.

5) NO STUDENTS MAY BE IN THE UPPER COMPUTER LAB AFTER SCHOOL UNLESS A TEACHER IS STAYING WITH THEM. ANY STUDENT NEEDING A COMPUTER AFTER SCHOOL IS TO MAKE ARRANGEMENTS WITH MRS. FLEMING TO USE A COMPUTER IN THE LOWER LAB. THEY CANNOT ASSUME THAT SHE WILL BE THERE UNLESS THEY HAVE MADE ARRANGEMENTS WITH HER.
