

STUDY HALL/ BEHAVIOR DETENTION INFORMATION AND PROCEDURES

NO STUDENT SHOULD STAY FOR STUDY HALL/ BEHAVIOR DETENTION UNLESS A PARENT IS NOTIFIED BY PHONE. ALL STUDENTS WILL CALL UPON FIRST NOTICE OF STUDY HALL/ BEHAVIOR DETENTION. IF THERE IS A PREEXISTING APPOINTMENT, PLEASE NOTIFY MRS. DOBLES IN ORDER TO MAKE ARRANGEMENTS TO STAY THE FOLLOWING EVENING.

AFTER SCHOOL SUPERVISION

Any student who stays for a homework detention/study hall is to go to the front lobby to wait for his/her ride, call and wait, or go to extended care. Only if a student is walking home may he/she leave out of another door. No student will be kept after longer than 4:10 p.m. unless he/she has notified a parent and received confirmation to be able to stay longer.

Any student staying for homework detention/study hall must stay a certain amount of time for each homework mark. They may not leave when their work is done unless their initial homework detention time is served. The minimum time is 25 minutes.

No students are to be outside after 3:20 p.m waiting for a ride anywhere on campus. They must come in and either go to extended care or call and check on the status of his/her ride and wait in the school lobby.

There should not be any fifth or sixth grade students staying on Friday, unless a parent has been notified and received confirmation from the teacher of keeping the student.

No students may be in the upper computer lab after school unless teacher is staying with them. Any student needing a computer after school is to make arrangements with Mrs. Fleming to use a computer in the lower lab. They cannot assume that she will be there unless they have made arrangements with her.

Any student left unattended in the building will be brought to Mrs. Grennan's attention. They will be sent to extended care.

1. Students must be in study hall immediately after the dismissal bell or have a note from homeroom teacher.
2. Students must have all supplies, backpacks, coats, etc.
3. Students must be seated in silence and working on assignment or a next day detention will be assigned.
4. Students must raise hand for teacher assistance.
5. No restroom or drink breaks during detention. Students will be allowed a break, if necessary

before the final dismissal bell.

6. No leaving room until dismissed to go home by the detention teacher when work is completed satisfactorily.
7. Students must show and hand in work to the detention teacher. All work is kept in a detention folder.
8. No going back to homeroom after detention to drop off books or other supplies.
9. All remaining students will leave by 4:00
10. Study hall is priority, detention to be served following.
11. Students in detention due to behavior will be assigned work by the detention teacher. The study hall/ detention teacher will read the assigned work before the student leaves the room.
12. If any student intentionally disregards any study hall/ behavior detention rules a mark will be placed on their card for the next day.
13. Students earning study hall will stay until 3:35.
14. If any student fails to attend an earned study hall/detention without teacher approval, they will serve an additional one hour detention.
15. A HALF HOUR BEHAVIOR DETENTION is GIVEN FOR ANY LONG TERM ASSIGNMENT NOT TURNED IN ON TIME, UNLESS A NOTE IS WRITTEN FROM THE PARENT(S).

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION.....

Receiving a study hall is the result of work not completed at the time it is due.

5 missing assignments and/or 8 behavior marks in one week constitutes a Saturday School.

The following are a few, but not all of the ways a student can earn a behavior detention:

- * Any behavior detention/study hall card lost by a student will require the student to pay a \$5.00 fine and the behavior detention card will be marked.
- * Any student who does not show up for detention or study hall and does not have an acceptable excuse that day, will serve an additional 1 hr. behavior detention the following night.

* Any student not following directions, rules or procedures of the classroom/school (including not having proper supplies for class, incomplete work and illegible work) will be given a behavior detention check mark.

* Any test or quiz or assignment that requires a signature that is not signed and returned the next day will be regarded as a behavior infraction and a check will be issued everyday that each test, quiz, or assignment is not signed.

* Any behavior check that results in detention received after 2:30 p.m. will require the student to stay the following afternoon for Study Hall/Detention.

note Absences have two school days or a weekend to catch up on missing work.

The following is the amount of time to be served per check on conduct card in one school day:

- 1- warning
- 2- 30 minutes
- 3- 1 hour
- 4- visit to Mrs. Grennan's office

Each assignment missing or incomplete will result in a half hour study hall.

The following describes the criteria assessed for a conduct grade in one week:

- 1- check for the week= A
- 2- checks for the week= B+
- 3- checks for the week= B
- 4- checks for the week= C+
- 5- checks for the week= C
- 6- checks for the week= D+
- 7- checks for the week=D
- 8 or more checks for the week= F in conduct for the week and Saturday School

The quarterly conduct grade is an average of the weekly conduct grade.
